Homes give people an opportunity to build better lives and communities. But how do Gilliam County residents fare?

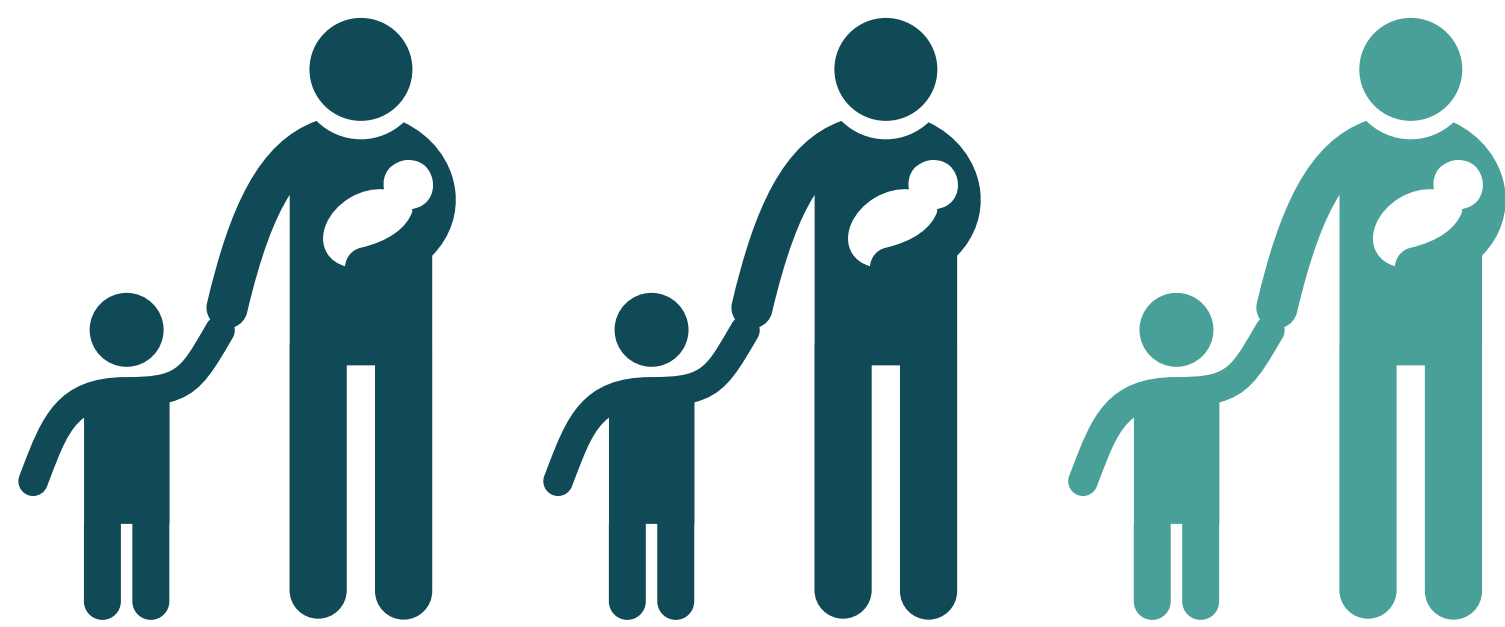
We have a serious shortage of affordable housing

For every 100 families with extremely low incomes, there are only 23 affordable units available.

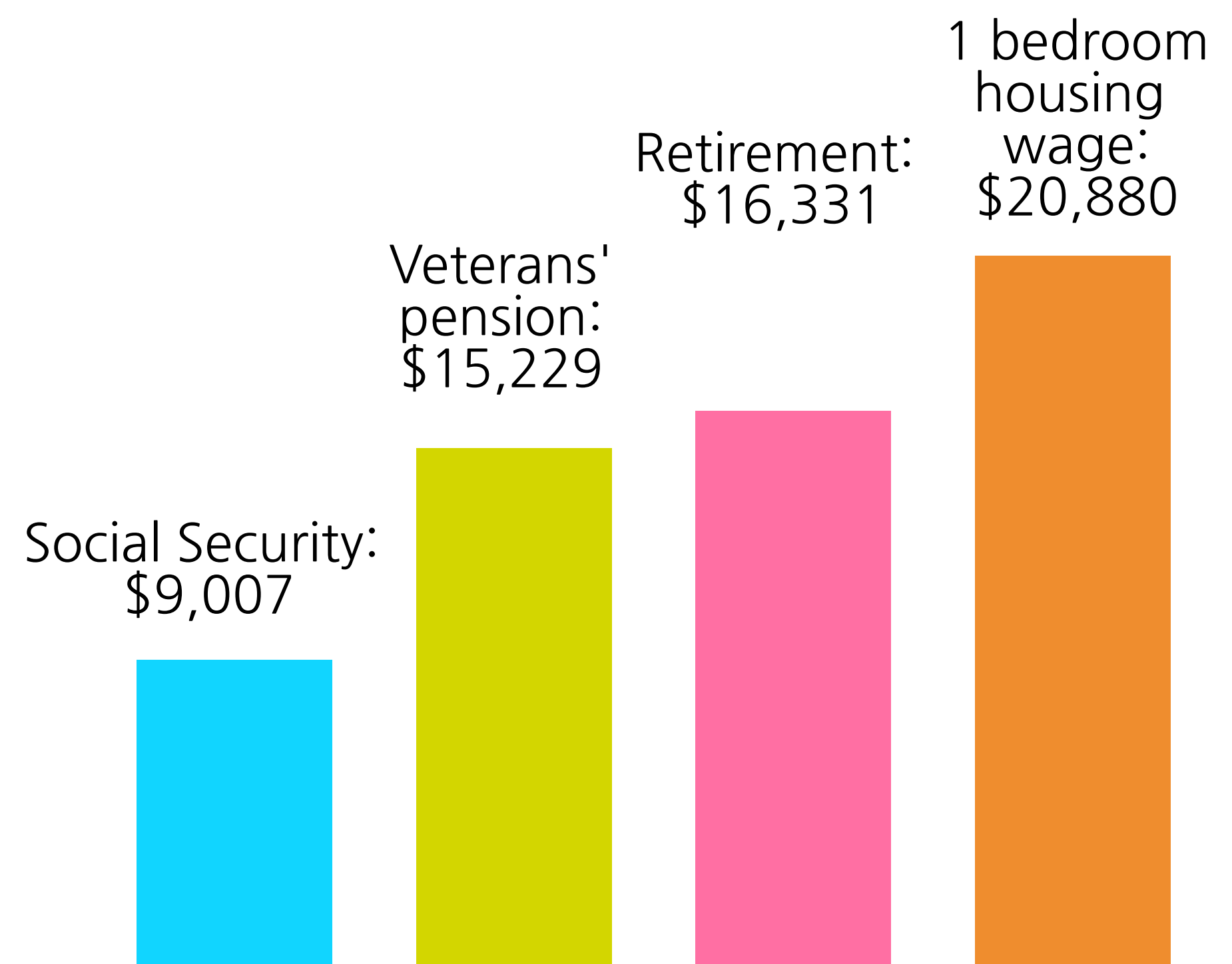


27 units are needed to meet the need

2 out of 3



renters with extremely low incomes are paying more than 50% of their income in rent



Oregonians on fixed incomes struggle to pay rent even for a one bedroom apartment.

Workers can't afford rent

A household must earn at least \$27,240 to afford a 2 bedroom apartment at fair market rent.
