For every 100 families with extremely low incomes, there are only 27 affordable units available.

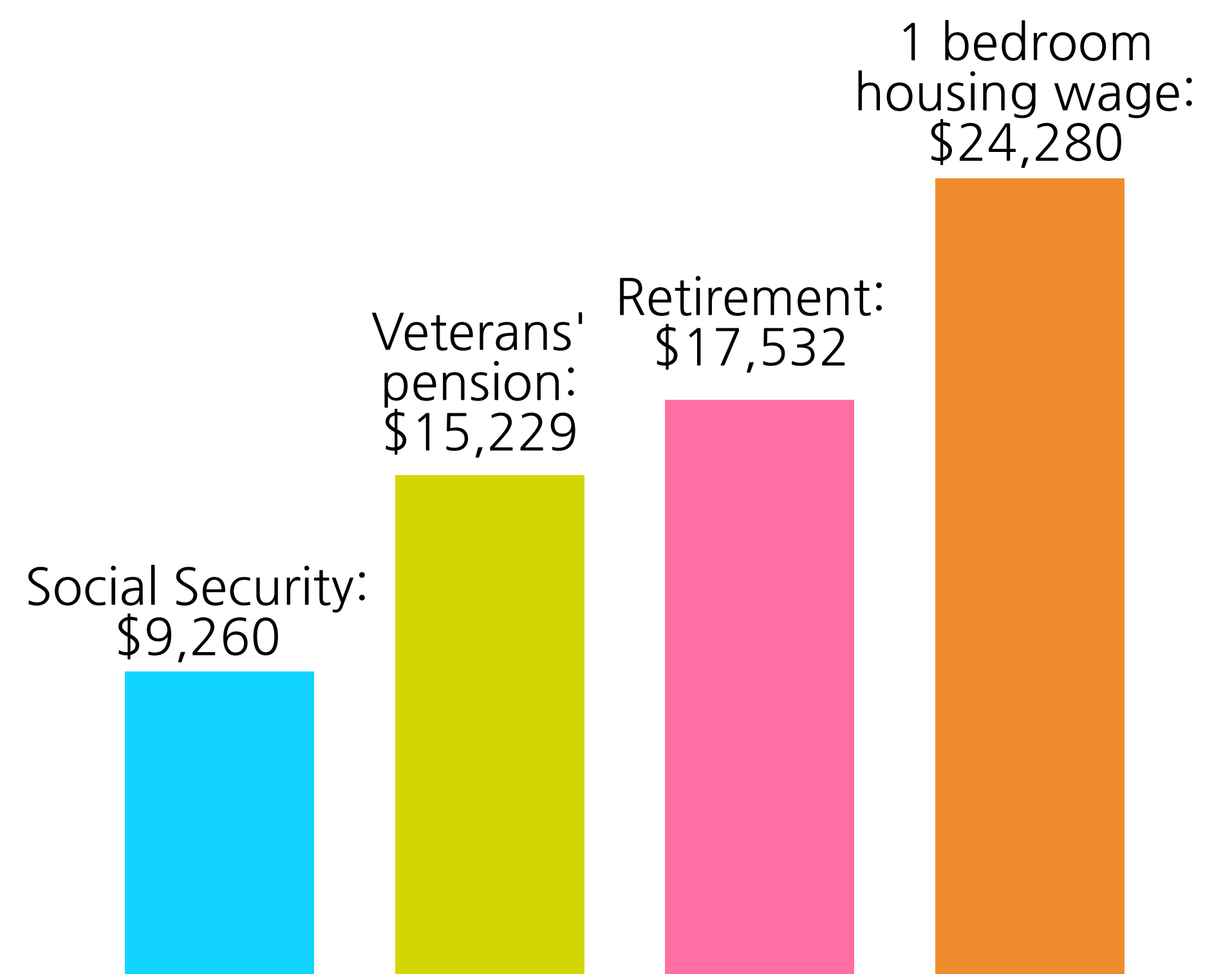


66 units are needed to meet the need

More than 3 out of 4



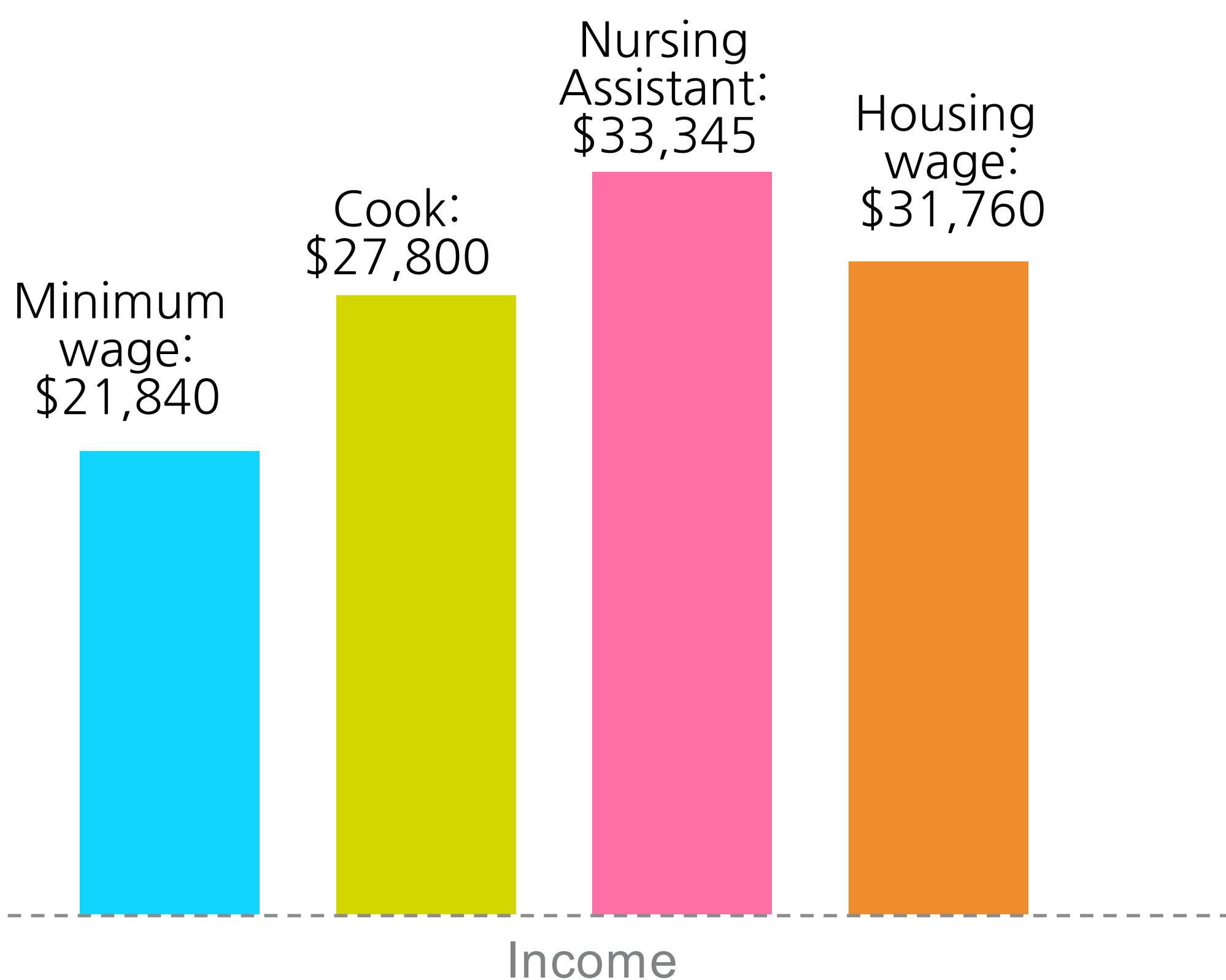
renters with extremely low incomes are paying more than 50% of their income in rent

Workers can't afford rent

A household must earn at least \$31,760 to afford a 2 bedroom apartment at fair market rent.
